

Evaluation summary

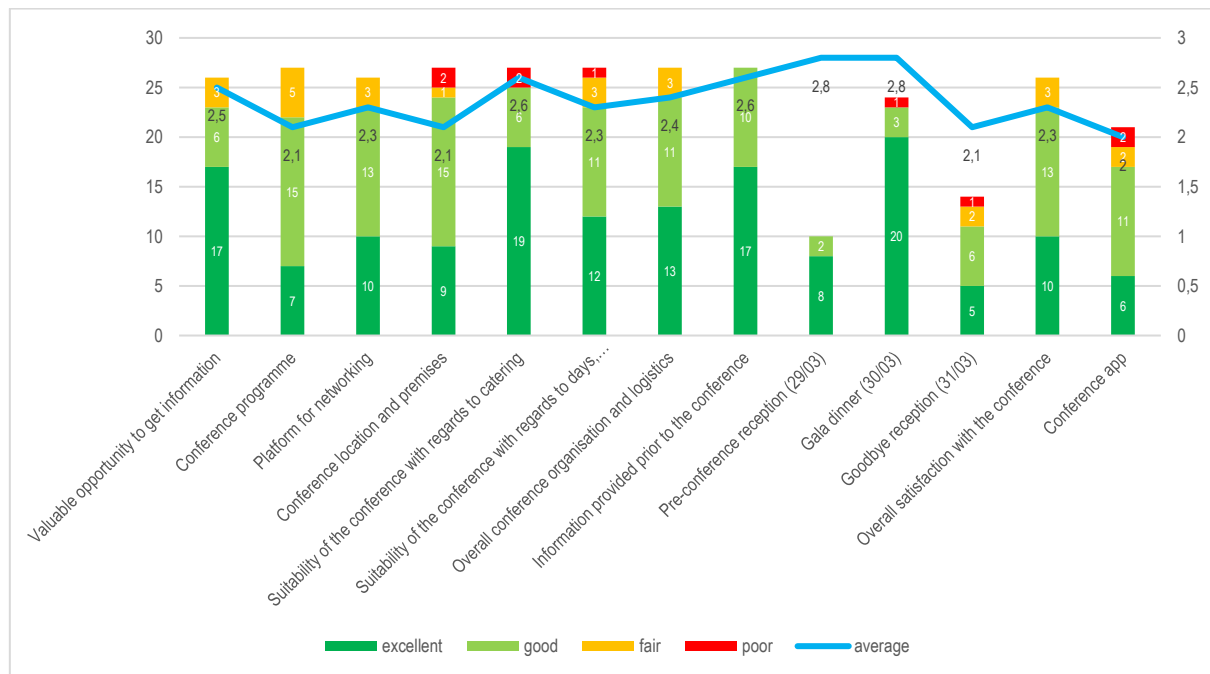
Participants in the conference 'Professional Higher Education 4.0: A Change for Universities of Applied Sciences' were invited to evaluate the conference per email. The evaluation took place for the first time for EURASHE events electronically only.

118 participants took part in the conference. Over a week after the conference, 27 evaluations were received – as well as some feedback provided through the event app. It represents a response rate of 22,9%. 77,8% of respondents represent higher education institutions (including universities, universities of applied sciences and university colleges).

The content of the conference was in general positively evaluated. The plenary on day 1, including the welcome and the keynote speeches are graded 2,3/3, the posters are graded 1,8/3, the good practices 2,3/3, the breakout 2,5/3, the UAS Leadership Forum 2,8/3, and the final plenary on day 2 with the summary and closing is graded 2/3.¹

Participants were asked to mention the sessions they liked the best. While there is a wide diversity due to the large number of speakers, the top speakers mentioned were Martin Edmondson/Amy Ward (breakout session), Nina Zugic (breakout session), Raimund Hudak/Anna Frankenberg (breakout session) and Raimonda Agnė Medešienė/Elinga Noreikaitė (breakout session).

Participants were asked to evaluate their general experience of the conference. Positive evaluations were given to the various aspects. The overall conference was graded with 2,3/3.



92,6% of respondents would recommend a EURASHE event to their colleagues.

Respondents made two general comments/suggestions for improvements:

- When providing/relying on an event app, appropriate Wi-Fi should be available,
- More attention should be given to catering when asking for dietary requirements.
