One of the main goal of the IUT of Nice - Côte d'Azur is to provide a solution to any students desiring to alternating and learning work.



- Modular training offers to the professional students the possibility to acquire skills. The students follow one or several modules taught in the IUT according to their need of training.



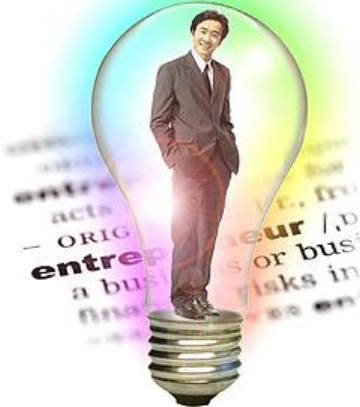
- The online modular training is a possibility offered to a professional to follow partly or entirely a degree by taking into account his validation of knowledge.



2. Experiential learning: The Cré@tude project

Experiential learning is the process of making meaning from direct experience.

Such a "learning by doing" perspective is concretely undertaken by the Cré@tude project managed by the University of Nice - Sophia Antipolis.



The main goal of the cré@atude project is to allow students or former students to become entrepreneurs.

The genesis of the Cré@tude

In the November 2009, the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research and the French Ministry of Economy, Industry and Employment launched a call for proposals to promote the desire to engage students and graduates by allowing them greater access to education tools, training and support.

This proposal was titled "**Création de pôles de l'entrepreneuriat étudiant**".

In this intention a project named "**Cré@tude**" was elaborated by the University of Nice Sophia Antipolis

The Cré@tude project is characterized by an unprecedented mobilization of the mains institutions of higher education (Universities of Nice - Sophia Antipolis and Toulon-Var and prestigious business schools), the institutions devoted to the promotion of innovation (several incubators located all around the French Riviera) and professional networks and employers unions

Cre@tude covers all levels of education (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate) and all stages of the entrepreneurial training (awareness, training, accompaniment).

The mobilization of all actors needed for these tasks is the real added value of this project.

Key Figures:

- 9000 students involved in entrepreneurship awareness
- 3000 Students formed in entrepreneurship as part of their curriculum
- 1 000 students supported in their entrepreneurship project

Budget estimate of the pole: 120 000 € / year (2011-2013)

Facilitation Team dedicated: 15 persons, full time or part-time

Teachers involved in the division's activities: 76 persons, full time or part-time

Main concrete actions of the project

- Optional education units in higher schools: The University of Nice-Sophia Antipolis and South Toulon Var offer to all undergraduate students optional training modules on the theme of creation or resumption of business in partnership and on the theme of the Business Plan with many economic actors;

- Full or partial funding of projects devoted to the firm creation by the University of Nice - Sophia Antipolis.



Main concrete actions of the project

- Internship for creating an enterprise. A student who has an entrepreneurship project can contract with the entrepreneurship office of the University. Then, he is paid during 6 months for the setting up of a firm. Each student entrepreneur is coached by a tutor from the the PACA EST incubator.



- The "Challenge Jeunes pousses" is a business plan contest. Several multidisciplinary teams present their entrepreneurial project within a 9 months period. During this period, they benefit training sessions devoted in entrepreneurship in the aim of being able to handle the different aspects of a firm creation project (marketing, human resources, logistics, finance...).



Main concrete actions of the project

- Setting up of a moodle platform devoted to the entrepreneurship.

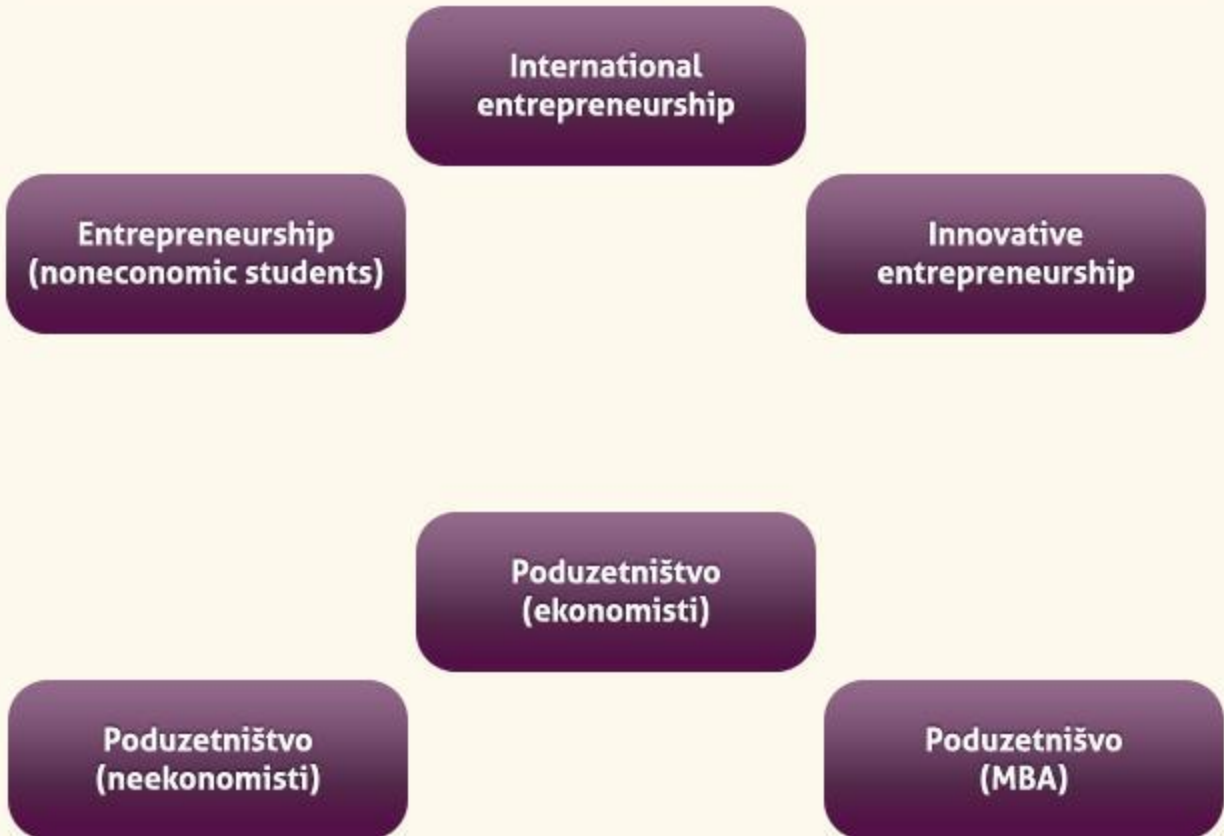
