- o The Netherlands
- o Network for people involved in Professional (Higher) Education
- o Strongly involved in implementing SCHE = the Associate degree in the Netherlands = level 5 of the NLQF (two years out of four for the Professional Bachelor)

More flexibility

- o For employees (working together with their employer on personal development and their career within the company)
- o Not only RPL for:
 - exemptions
 - shorter programmes
 - 'Swiss cheese' programmes
 - less study workload

More flexibility

- o Proposal for a pilot... from the business perspective – to change the regulations...
- o Using a period of 2 till 3 years to complete the first year of a formal SCHE programme – and to start at the beginning of an academic year with the second year of the Associate degree
- o The focus will be on the combination of:
 - non-formal learning (job related)
 - work experience (relevant)
 - projects (using SCHE competences)
- o Guided and recognised by RPL experts of the SCHE provider

And...

- o Using a percentage of the wages for RPL
- o Recognised by the Ministry of Education
- o Part of accreditation
- o Public Financed (if the HEI is financed that way)

- o A new 'dual' learning pathway for 'permeability between VET/Work and HE...'
- o And maybe leading to a new qualification – more 'work-based learning'...
- o And maybe 'pay per module'
