RPL in HE and VET (NL)

Challenge to improve the Quality of RPL/the RPL report

PRESENT

- national RPL-register:
 - registration of recognised RPL-providers and RPL procedures
- national expertise centre on RPL offering:
 - a national RPL quality code
 - a handbook, including good examples
 - RPL training
- independent external control and accreditation

CHALLENGE to guarantee the:

- quality of RPL-procedures
- quality and uniformity of external quality control
- quality of the (RPL) assessors
- the internal quality
- the numbers of participants

RPL in HE and VET (NL)

Challenge to improve the quantity of RPL :

- enlarging the numbers of participants, especially at HE-level
- saving the numbers of participants in HE and VET, offering RPL

RPL in HE and VET (NL)

Challenge to improve the effectiveness of RPL :

- RPL is still a not well known assessment tool
 - in education
 - at the labour market
- the recognition of a RPL report, supported by another institution

RPL in HE and VET (NL)

Challenge to improve the conversion into education

- tailor made education and training modules
- the flexibility of education and training
- the possibilities combining
'work, education and private life'

Recognition of Prior Learning

- Competencies:
combination of talents, knowledge, skills and values
- Positive attitude towards someone's achievements;
not only taking diplomas in account, but also working
experience, prior jobs, voluntary work, second jobs,
hobbies etc.
- Not by education but learned by practice
- It is an admission for starting or exemption for a (part) of
an education.
- Certificate is legal
