To become a member of the European Association of Institutions in Higher Education, or EURASHE in short, fill in this application form. Your application will be examined and decided upon by the Board of EURASHE, which meets at least four times per year. EURASHE has three categories of membership:

- (1) **Full membership:** open to national associations of higher education institutions in the EHEA and higher education institution within the EHEA;
- (2) **Associate membership:** open to international sectorial associations of higher education institutions within the EHEA;
- (3) **Affiliate membership:** open to recognised individual higher education institution and associations of higher education institutions outside the EHEA; institutions of higher education or national associations of higher education institutions within the EHEA that do not meet all full membership criteria; as well as any other bona fide organisation active in the field of higher education worldwide.

In order to become a member, you will need to meet the following criteria:

[for national/sectorial associations of higher education institutions within and outside the EHEA]

- have a legal entity and represent a number of higher education institutions or be a 'de facto' association (e.g. subgroup of a rectors' conference).

[for higher education institutions within and outside the EHEA]

- be a recognised and quality assured higher education institution legally operating in the country where it is established.

[for all other organisations]

- be a bona fide stakeholder active in the field of higher education (e.g. qualifications council, quality assurance agency, etc.).

Your membership is subject to the payment of a membership fee to EURASHE. Organisations that are granted membership through the year will pay the pro-rata amount of the annual fee based on the month in which they join. Further information on the fee structure is available on our [website](#).
