

CALL FOR EURASHE BOARD CANDIDATES

Mandate 2025-2027

EURASHE hereby announces a call for candidates for the election of all nine elected Board members at a meeting of the General Assembly on 13th May 2025 in Portalegre, Portugal (the day before the 34th Annual Conference). The term for Board members is two years.

Board membership is a non-paid executive position. EURASHE covers costs for Board meetings and representation according to its travel reimbursement policy. The Board usually meets monthly online, with two meetings a year held in person. Board members are expected to represent EURASHE, oversee its strategy and work plans, contribute to its activities and supervise its Secretariat.

Process

Candidates can be nominated by full members of EURASHE, before the deadline of 31st March 2025, according to the instructions set out below. Elections will take place at the General Assembly in Portalegre on 13th May 2025 (information on time and venue will be circulated to in advance). Candidates may still be elected if they do not physically attend the General Assembly, as the meeting will be held in hybrid format. According to the bylaws, candidates are invited to make a statement to the General Assembly before the election. This year, these statements will be made online in advance of the elections, at a meeting on Friday 2nd May from 12:00 – 14:00 CET.

Presidency elections

According to the EURASHE bylaws, the newly elected Board will convene immediately and seek candidacies among its members for the positions of the President and two Vice-Presidents. The General Assembly will then elect, from the candidates nominated by the Board, the President and Vice-Presidents of EURASHE for a two year mandate.

Instructions for candidates

Candidates are requested to submit the following documents, which will be distributed to the General Assembly.

1. A letter of endorsement signed by the full member's legal representative.
2. A vision statement on the strategy for EURASHE, ideas for its implementation and personal role during the mandate. This can be in written form (max three pages), or a recording (max five minutes).
3. An accompanying letter stating a willingness to accept the nomination and to assume the office (max one page);
4. A CV with a photo (max two pages);
